Student artwork is displayed at every turn, working visual artists provide hands-on arts encounters, and professional artists perform in the state-of-the-art auditorium, resulting in a powerful yet playful day of learning suitable for the entire family.

The *KAI Performance Series* has increasingly become more popular. Designed to bring full length quality performances to the Kaneland Community, the KAI Performance Series will showcase artists at the Kaneland Auditorium in throughout the school year. Instituted in 2012, *the KAI Artist in Residency* offers students *real world* Arts experiences as student connect with professional artists throughout the school year. Students learn how the Arts play a contributing role in the world around them through the eyes and experiences of these professionals.

Individuals, recently retired art teacher, Bonnie Whildin and retired Superintendent of Schools, Dr. Charles McCormick, were honored by the *Illinois Alliance for Arts Education (IAAE)* in 2011 for their work for the Fine Arts in Kaneland, specifically for the Festival.

Thanks to the generosity of the Dunham Fund (\$25,000), and Kaneland Parent-Teacher Associations (\$8,000), KAI has committed funding as solid foundation for the upcoming community celebrations of the arts.
